I feel that in order for the sponsors to maintain our respect, they should use the stairs for the remainder on the week.





In case it's what you were thinking, no, this does not include speakers at assemblies. These are people who are taking their own time to see how things are running at Boys' State.

Above, I mentioned the media. Yes, we are newsworthy. Yesterday, Abby Bleck, a reporter from Fox channel 6, came to the K-State campus with notebook and camera in hand. She was guided through the campus and given a little summary of what was happening in each meeting by American Legion member Mark Evans. KILLER EARTHQUAKE OFF INDONESIA

Jakarts, June 5- A powerful earthquake and numerous aftershocks rocked the Indonesian island of Sumatra overnight, killing 58 people, injuring hundreds and causing widespread panic, officials and local media said on Monday. Thousands were left homeless, numbers that could rise sharply as more information emerges from a province where the damage has cut off communication with the outside world. The quake measured 7.9 on the richter scale and struck late on Sunday. It is reported that the death toll is likely to climb higher because they have not yet been able to contact the worst-hit areas.
