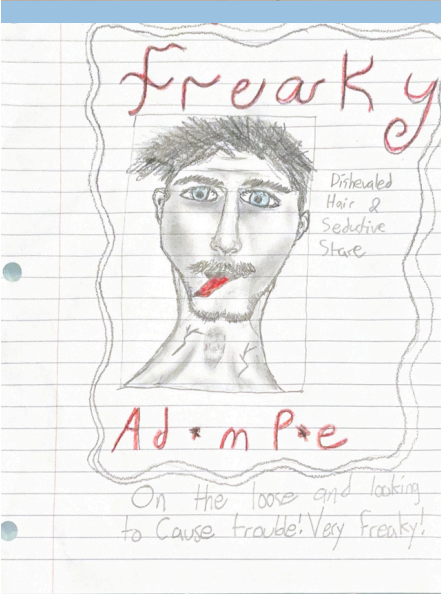

## Doles Dissappearance

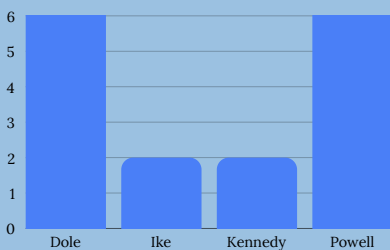

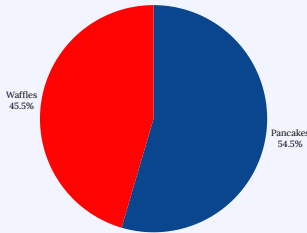


# How do you Dispose of a Flag Properly?

# Kennedy County Lottery Case

Kennedy County's lone defendant has entered a plea with the Executive Branch, following a meeting with all members of the Executive Branch.
